The City Council of Newton, Iowa met in special session at 6:00 P.M. on the above date in the Council Chambers at 101 West 4th Street South. Mayor Hansen presided. Present Council Members: George, Stonner, Trotter, Mullan, Kulis. Absent: None.

Resolution ordering bids, approving plans, specifications and form of contract and notice to bidders, and ordering clerk to publish notice and fixing a date for receiving same, and for a public hearing on plans, specifications, form of contract and estimate of costs for the Library Renovation Project. Resolution 2018-028 adopted.
