The City Council of Newton, Iowa met in special session at 6:00 P.M. on the above date in the Council Chambers at 101 West 4th Street South. Mayor Hansen presided. Present Council Members: George, Hallam arrived at 6:02 p.m., Stonner, Trotter, Mullan, Kulis. Absent: None.

Mayor Hansen asked everyone present to join in saying the Pledge of Allegiance.

Moved by Stonner, seconded by Kulis to approve consent agenda items 1-2.

1. Approve Special Event on February 18, 2018 Liquor License Class C Liquor and Sunday Sales for Fore Seasons Golf, 3333 Rusty Wallace Drive, pending completion of State requirements.

2. Resolution setting a public hearing and inviting proposals for the sale of property at 921 West 22nd Street South in Newton. Resolution 2018-042 adopted.
